#### ONLY ONE ENTRANCE TO THE CATHEDRAL: BLUE AWNING DOOR

**Entering the Cathedral:** Please note that there will be only one entrance to the Cathedral. This entrance is located at the **Blue Awning Door** on the south side of the Cathedral. Please use this entrance only as all others will remained closed.

## DURING THIS FIRST PHASE OF RE-OPENING ALL ATTENDEES MUST ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES BASED ON THE METROPOLIS OF ATLANTA

- Pre-registration is required to attend all services. Pre-registration sign-up information can be found at: <a href="www.atlgoc.org">www.atlgoc.org</a>.
   Pre-Registered parishioners must arrive no later than <a href="30 minutes">30 minutes</a> before the Service begins, by reporting to the Blue Awning Door Entrance. <a href="Doors will be closed after the 30 minute check-in time">Doors will be closed after the 30 minute check-in time</a>.
- 2. During this first phase of re-opening a limited number of households will be permitted at each worship service. Extra services will be offered to accommodate everyone.
- 3. Although local laws may not require masks to be worn, everyone attending services is required to wear a mask from age 2 and above. Please bring a mask from home.
- 4. Before entering the Cathedral, each person will be checked in by a parish volunteer.
- 5. Each person's temperature will be taken.
- 6. Hands must be sanitized upon entry.
- 7. Follow the queue line that has been outlined in the Narthex.
- 8. After lighting a candle(s), you will be directed to an assigned seat by an usher and are asked to remain in that area for the duration of the service. Red (7-Day) Candles will be placed and lit on your behalf. Cashless offerings preferred.
- 9. Honor the icons and other sacred objects by a reverent bow and making the sign of the Cross instead of kissing.
- 10. Refrain from shaking hands or kissing others before, during and after the service.
- 11. Instructions for receiving Holy Communion and antidoron will be explained by the clergy.
- 12. At the conclusion of the service, please exit by the two glass side doors in the Nave of the Cathedral and return to your vehicle without congregating.



#### Want to Reduce your Tax Liability? Participate in the APOGEE State Scholarship Fund

This program uses Georgia State Tax dollars to fund private school scholarships. The money goes directly to ADS to fund scholarships for students in need. Here's how it works: Individual filers can contribute up to \$1,000, joint filers up to \$2,500, and C Corps up to 75% of GA tax liability. Additionally, S Corps and/or partners in an LLC can contribute up to \$10,000 each year. You will receive a dollar-for-dollar GA tax credit for the amount of your contribution. If you pay your taxes throughout the year, you can still participate. The tax credit is based on your total GA tax liability (6% of your stated adjusted gross income) and not on what you may or may not still owe the State at the end of the year.
