The 2021/2022 scholarship application process is now open!

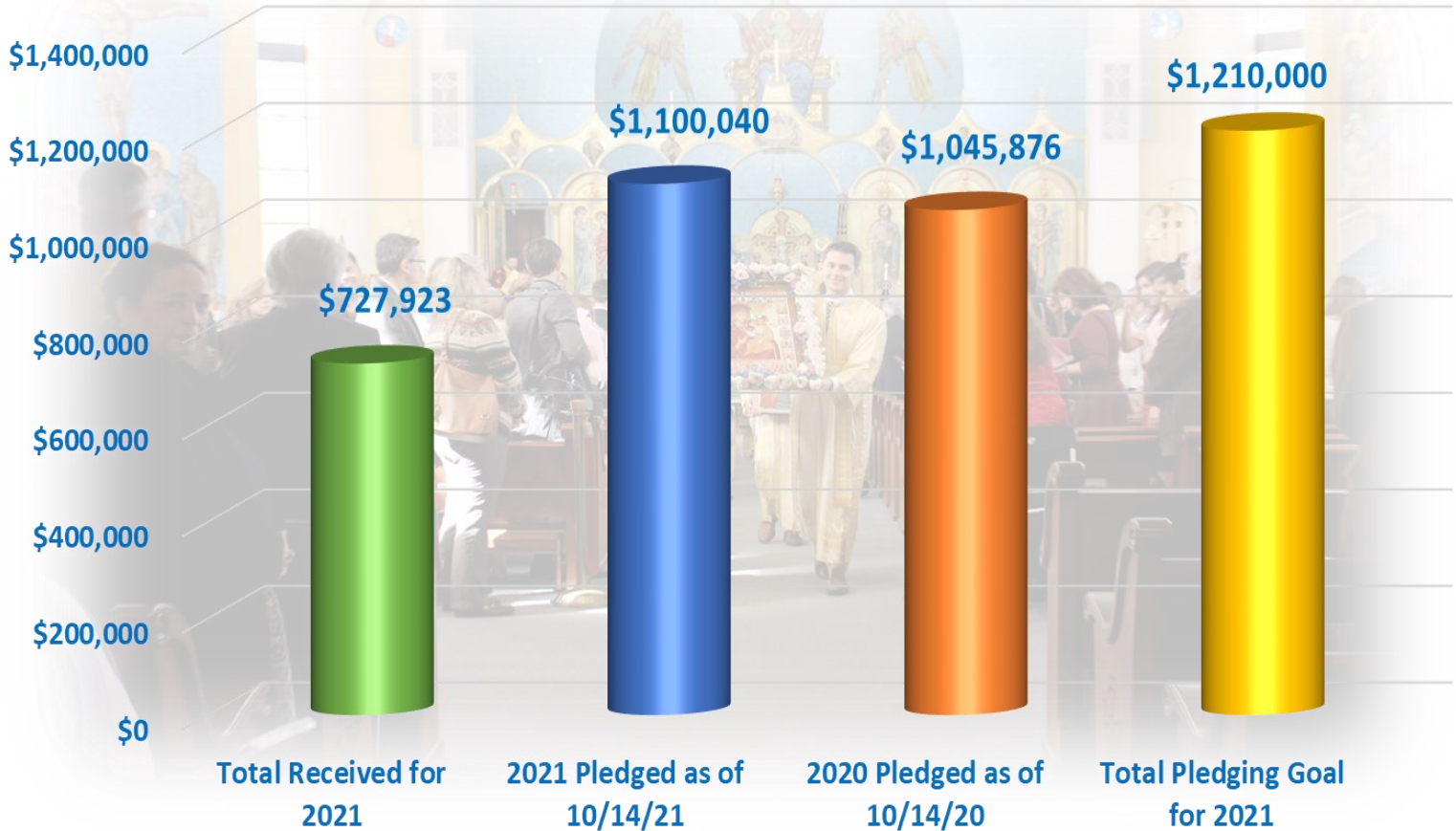
The Foundation will accept applications from eligible Greek American college students.

- ❖ ICM Teams personally go under the bridges, in the parks, homeless encampments – wherever the homeless and hungry congregate to bring food and clothing. They have had success in assisting to place some of the chronically homeless into their own apartments. To these, the ICM Teams deliver groceries from the Pantry.
