
What is Wednesday Nite Life?

Back to Basics (Learning our Faith)

This course aims to introduce the wealth of Liturgical Tradition of our Orthodox Church. After a brief study on the Early Christian centuries and the development of the Orthodox Rite, a person will learn:

- 1) The life, the sacraments, and services of the Orthodox Church
- 2) Major feasts of the Ecclesiastical Year
- 3) Saints of the Orthodox Church

Road to Orthodoxy Part 1

This course is designed for those who are interested in embracing the Orthodox Faith as well as for those who would like to “brush up” on their rudimentary knowledge of the Orthodox faith.
